NCACCT Western Region Trustee Training

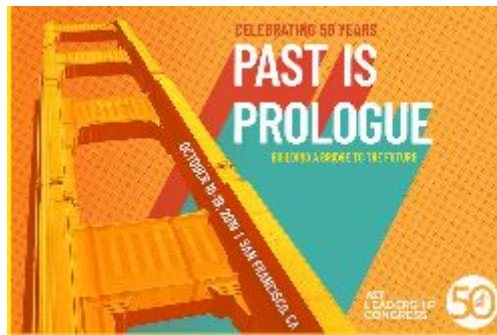
